

DPRK halts missile program

On February 23-24, the Democratic People's Republic of Korea announced a moratorium on uranium enrichment program and long-range missile tests, and expressed the possibility to let IAEA experts work in the DPRK during DPRK-US high-level talks in Beijing, China. On March 6, B. Dorj, a spokesman of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Mongolia, told the MONTSAME National News Agency, that the Mongolian side appreciates the positive tendency for the DPRK-USA talks.
